The European research project

AGE-15 addresses the challenges of urban ageing, such as housing types, unwanted isolation, accessibility, and safety. It explores how the 15-Minute City concept can contribute to create age-friendly neighbourhoods, improve mobility, as well as collaborative living environments that enhance social connection while supporting older adults' everyday life. Through case studies in Sweden, the Netherlands, Portugal, and Turkey, AGE-15 co-creates innovative transition pathways including researchers, municipalities, municipal housing companies, and older adults.
