FROM WATERFRONTS TO WATERSCAPES - TOWARD A NEW COASTAL ONTOLOGY MARIA GOULA, CORNELL UNIVERSITY.

In the lecture, Maria Goula, will introduce and discuss relevant contemporary waterfront designs in New York City as part of the Hudson and East rivers' estuaries with the aim to reflect on the interrelation of histories, design approaches and emerging values about the coast as a landscape.

Dr. Maria Goula is Associate Professor at the Landscape Architecture Department, Cornell University. She is also adjunct researcher at the Institute for Research on Habitat, Territory and Tourism, ihtt, UPC, UMa, developing research on coastal tourism, especially in regard to the interpretation of leisure patterns and coastal dynamics. Maria Goula is also a licenced Architect (1990) and Landscape Architect (MLA 1996, UPC) with a Ph.D. (2007, UPC) on Landscape Theory. She is a foundation member of the Scientific Board of International Landscape Architecture Biennial, Barcelona, [2000- present].
